The Delta Psi Sigma Foundation was established as a 501(c)3 organization with a Mission aimed at supporting the Greater Seattle area to affect change and influence the livelihood of women and their families.

Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. was founded on November 12, 1922, in Indianapolis, Indiana, on the campus of Butler University, by seven young educators. Sigma Gamma Rho's aim is to enhance the quality of life within the community. The aim of the Delta Psi Sigma Chapter is to promote educational awareness, serve as advocates for social issues facing the Seattle/King County community, and provide opportunities for continuous personal and professional growth for its members and community-at-large.

Both organizations address concerns that impact society educationally, civically, and economically.

The 2022 Centennial Scholarship was formed as a partnership in 2022 to commemorate the founding of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. and to continue the generosity, legacy of excellence of the Delta Psi Sigma Foundation, and to encourage and support the higher education endeavors of the students in the Greater Seattle community.

Considering the mission of the Delta Psi Sigma Foundation and the founding of the sorority by seven schoolteachers and their commitment to the well-being of our youth through education and mentorship, this scholarship is awarded with the understanding of the necessity of education in achieving personal and professional career aspirations. Recipients of the 2022 Centennial Scholarship will receive notification via email.



Scholarship Criteria:

1. Applicants must be: a) current High school senior or college student in the 2022-2023 academic school year and,
b) Be a female member of an under-represented ethnic group.
2. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale.
3. Reside in the Seattle and Surrounding Counties area.

Scholarship Amount

The scholarship award is \$1000

Availability

The one-time scholarship is for use in the current academic year. The deadline for requesting scholarship funds is January 31st, of the award year. Awardees not attending school Win/Spring term must submit a letter requesting a delay of funds. Funds not requested by **July 30th that same year**, will not be awarded.

Instructions:

You will need to respond to one of the following essay prompts (300 - 650 word max).
 1. *How will your choice of college major impact your community?*
 2. *Describe a major life event and how it made you into the person you are today.*
 3. *Discuss a time you failed and what you learned from it.*
 4. *Is there a moral/ethical obligation or to receive a COVID-19 vaccination? Why or Why not*
2. If selected for the scholarship, you will be required to provide proof of enrollment. Funds will be disbursed directly to the recipient.
